

How to Obtain IRB Approval for CIRTification

This process applies to both online and in-person training

- 1. UIC Principal Investigators (PIs) should contact OPRS (<u>uicirb@uic.edu</u> or 312-996-1711) to discuss the use of CIRTification for their community partners.
- 2. If, after discussion with OPRS staff, CIRTification appears to be a viable option for the training of their community partners, UIC PIs should:
 - 2.1. Indicate the planned use of CIRTification for their community partners in their Initial Review application/research protocol.
 - 2.2. Include in the Initial Review application a justification for the use of CIRTification for the community partners' training.
 - 2.3. IF the roles of the community partners reach the threshold for being Key Research Personnel (https://research.uic.edu/human-subjects-irbs/education-training/), list the community partners individually by name on Appendix P to be included with the Initial Review application.
 - 2.4. IF the roles of the community partners do NOT reach the threshold for being KRP, the community partners do not need to be listed individually on Appendix P; however, the PI is responsible to ensure that individuals receive both adequate training, including human subjects protection, and oversight in accordance to their research roles.
- 3. After the IRB reviews and approves the research, including the planned use of CIRTification for community partner training, community partners designated in the initial review application can complete CIRTification training.
- 4. After completing CIRTification training, community partners must print or save their completion certificates and provide a copy to the UIC PI.
- 5. The UIC PI is responsible for providing the completion certificates to OPRS as needed.
